Relationship with the Church: Review

Text: 1 Corinthians 12, Matthew 16:13-18, Ephesians 4, 2 Corinthians 5:11-21, Acts 2:36-40, 1 Corinthians 11:23-28

Main Point: Church = Christianity

This week we will review our series on our relationship with the church, focusing on our main points from each week. We will emphasize the connection between our own dependence on God and the importance/role of the church in our lives.

Questions:

1. Why do you think it is important to be a part of the church? Do you really think it matters for you as a 5th or 6th grader? Why or why not?

3. Does God use the church to strengthen your relationship with Him? How important is the church to someone that is a Christian? Why? How does the answer to this question connect to the answer to question 2?
4. Do you think you have a part to play in the church? What is that role? Are you fulfilling it?
5. Why does the Bible tell us to be baptized?
6. Why should Christians be baptized? When should they be baptized?
7. Do you think that communion is important? Why or why not?
8. What are some things you have learned about the church over the past month? How have these things shaped or changed the way you view church?
