Extended Small Group Time
The Gospel

Text: Ephesians 2:1-10

Main Point: *The Gospel is our only hope.*

Read through the text as a small group. Have your students take some time to write out their answer to the first question. Don't help them; have them try to answer it on their own. As they share their answers, use the rest of the questions to continue to push them to think about what the Gospel is and how it changes who we are and our relationships with others.

Questions:

1. What is the Gospel?
2. Who needs the Gospel? Why is it the most important thing? (1 Cor 15:1-4) Why do you need the Gospel? Do you only need the Gospel once, when you choose to believe in Jesus? Why do you need it all the time?
3. How/why does the Gospel matter in your relationships?
4. Have each student pick one relationship that is very important to them (father, mother, siblings, friend). What is your biggest struggle in this relationship? How can the Gospel change/fix/help with this struggle? What is your sin in this struggle? How does the Gospel fix your sin?
