Week 15
Relationship with Siblings

Text: 1 John 2:4-11

Main Point: *Christians love their brothers and sisters.*

Coming off of our discussion regarding parents, this week's lesson should be very similar in application and practicality. We will look at 1 John 2 which clearly states that the way we treat each other is a revelation of our love for God. The goal is to prove to our students that the way they treat their siblings reveals their heart, their sin and what they really believe about God, themselves and others.

Questions:

1. Do you ever struggle to love your siblings? Why?
2. Do you think it is important to love your siblings? Why?
3. Does the way you treat your brothers and sisters reflect how much you love Jesus? Why or why not? (Spend some time re-reading 1 John 2 if they are struggling with this concept.)
4. What are some ways you could build a closer relationship with your siblings?
5. Can you love Jesus and not love your brothers and sisters?
6. What does it mean to love your brothers and sisters?
