**Relationship with God**  
**The Gospel**

**Text:** Ephesians 2:1-10, Genesis 1, 3, Romans 1, 1 Corinthians 15:1-4

**Main Point:** *The Gospel is for everyone, every day, all the time!*

*This week we are going to recap what the gospel is and spend most of our time talking about how the gospel is for “real life”. We will re-define the gospel and how it is important for everyone. The goal is for the students to understand more clearly the gospel is not just for non-Christians but that it is for everyone, every day, all the time!*

**Questions:**

1. Define religion – What is religion? (If they are having trouble, once again, give them the phrase “God loves me because I.....Anything they use to finish the sentence should let them know that they are being religious)
2. What is the difference between religion and the gospel?
3. What are some ways that you act religious?
4. Who needs the gospel? Christians or non-Christians?
5. Why is the gospel the most important thing for all people?
